



Passenger Code of Conduct for

The Loop Trolley System

Revision 2.2 | October 5, 2018

1. Terms and Descriptions

As used in this section, the following terms have the following meanings:

- 1) Conveyance – includes trolleys used by the system as a means of transportation of passengers.
- 2) Facilities – includes all property and equipment, including, without limitation, rights-of-way and related trackage, rails, signals, power, fuel, communication and ventilation systems power systems and substations, station stops, terminals, signage, storage areas, repair and maintenance shops, yards, offices and maintenance vehicles.
- 3) Person – any individual, firm, co-partnership, corporation, association or company.
- 4) Sound production device – means and includes, but is not limited to, any radio received, phonograph, television receiver, musical instrument, tape recorded, compact disk player, cassette player, speaker device and any sound amplifier.
- 5) System – the Loop Trolley System owned by the Loop Trolley Transportation Development District, a political subdivision of Missouri, and operated by the Loop Trolley Company.

2. Interpretation

In interpreting or applying this section, the following provisions shall apply:

- 1) Rules shall apply with equal force to any person assisting, aiding or abetting another, including a minor, in any of the acts prohibited by the rules or assisting, aiding or abetting another in the avoidance of any of the requirements of the rules; and
- 2) The singular shall mean and include the plural; the masculine gender shall mean the feminine and the neuter genders; and vice versa.
- 3) Any act otherwise prohibited by this Code is lawful if performed by an officer, employee or designated agent of Loop Trolley Company acting within the scope of his or her employment or agency.

3. Violations

- 1) No person shall use or enter upon the trolley conveyances of the system without payment of the fare or other lawful charges established by the system. Any person on any such conveyance must have properly validated fare media in his possession;
- 2) No person shall use any token, pass, badge, ticket, document, transfer, card or fare media to gain entry to the facilities or conveyances of, or make use of the services of, the system, except as provided, authorized or sold by the system in accordance with any restriction on the use thereof imposed by the system;
- 3) Except for employees of the system acting within the scope of their employment, no person shall sell, provide, copy, reproduce or produce, or create any version of any token, pass, badge, ticket, document, transfer, card or any other fare media or otherwise authorize access to or use of the facilities, conveyances or services of the system without the written permission of an authorized representative of the system;
- 4) No person shall put or attempt to put any paper, article, instrument or item, other than a token, ticket, badge, coin, fare card, pass, transfer or other access authorization or other fare media issued by the system and valid for the place, time and manner in which used, into any fare box, pass reader, ticket vending machine or other fare collection instrument, receptacle, device, machine, or location;
- 5) Tokens, tickets, fare cards, badges, passes, transfers or other fare media that have been forged, counterfeited, imitated, altered or improperly transferred or that have been used in a manner inconsistent with this section shall be confiscated.
- 6) No person may perform any act which would interfere with the provision of the transit service or obstruct the flow of traffic on facilities or conveyances or which would in any way interfere or tend to interfere with the safe and efficient operation of the facilities or conveyances of the system;
- 7) All persons on or in any facility or conveyance of the system shall:
 - a) Comply with all lawful orders and directives of any system employee acting within the scope of his employment or any local law enforcement official;
 - b) Obey any restrictions on notices or signs duly posted on any system facility or conveyance, and
 - c) Provide accurate, complete and true information or documents requested by the system personnel acting within the scope of their employment and otherwise in accordance with law;
- 8) No person shall falsely represent himself or herself as an agent, employee or representative of the system;
- 9) No person on or in any facility or conveyance shall:

- a) Litter, dump garbage, liquids or other matter, or create a nuisance, hazard or unsanitary condition, including, but not limited to, spitting and urinating, except in facilities provided.
 - b) Drink any alcoholic beverage or possess any opened or unsealed container of alcoholic beverage, except on premises duly licensed for the sale of alcoholic beverages
 - c) Enter or remain in any facility or conveyance while his ability to function safely in the environment of the system is impaired by the consumption of alcohol or by the taking of any drug;
 - d) Loiter or stay on any facility of the system;
 - e) Consume foods or liquids of any kind, except in those areas specifically authorized by the system, or on occasions specifically authorized by the system;
 - f) Smoke or carry an open flame or lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or torch, except in those areas or locations specifically authorized by the system; or
 - g) Use electronic cigarettes and similar products designed to deliver nicotine or other non-medical substances to a user in the form of a vapor
 - h) Throw or cause to be propelled any stone, projectile or other article at, from, upon or in a facility or trolley conveyance.
 - i) Create any unreasonable noise through the use of any sound production device. Use of radios and other devices listened to solely by headphones or earphones and inaudible to others is permitted.
 - j) Interfere with any lamp, electric light, or electric fixture
 - k) Destroy, mark, soil or paint, or draw, inscribe, write, spray paint or place graffiti upon, or remove, injure or tamper with any facility, conveyance, sign, advertisement or notice of the Loop Trolley Company or authorized by the Loop Trolley Company.
 - l) Solicit funds through panhandling or performance of a vocal, physical or musical nature.
- 10) No weapon or other instrument intended for use as a weapon may be carried in or on any facility or conveyance, except for law enforcement personnel. For the purposes hereof, a weapon shall include, but not be limited to, a firearm, switchblade knife, sword, or any other instrument of any kind known as blackjack, Billy club, sandbag, metal knuckles, leather bands studded with metal, wood impregnated with metal filings and razor blades, except that this subdivision shall not apply to a rifle or shotgun which is unloaded and carried in any enclosed case, box or container which completely conceals the item from view and identification as a weapon.
- 11) No explosives, flammable liquids, acids, fireworks or other highly combustible materials or radioactive materials may be carried on or in any facility or conveyance, except as authorized by the system.
- 12) No person, except as specifically authorized by the system, shall enter or attempt to enter into any area not open to the public, including, but not limited to, motorman's cabs, trolley yards, garages, depots or any other area marked with a sign restricting access or indicating a dangerous environment.
- 13) No person may ride on the roof, the space between a coupled conveyance, or on any other area outside any trolley conveyance operated by the system.

- 14) No person shall extend his hand, arm, leg, head or other part of his or her person or extend any item, article or other substance outside of the window or door of a moving trolley conveyance operated by the system;
- 15) No person shall enter or leave a trolley car operated by the system except through the entrances and exits provided for that purpose.
- 16) No animals may be taken on or into any trolley conveyance or facility except the following:
 - a) An animal enclosed in a container, accompanied by the passenger and carried in a manner which does not annoy other passengers; and
 - b) Working dogs for law enforcement agencies, dogs properly harnessed and accompanying blind or hearing-impaired persons to aid such persons, or dogs accompanying trainers carrying a certificate of identification issued by a dog school.
- 17) Bicycles are prohibited on conveyances, except when specifically authorized by permit of the Loop Trolley Company.
